ROSE BAY HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC. ADDITIONAL PARKING GUIDANCE

Dear Homeowners, this is a reminder that you are responsible for obeying the parking rules in Rose Bay when you have gatherings. You should:

- 1. Coordinate your guest parking so that they do not park in the no-parking zones, which can be found at the bottom of the page on the HOA website at: https://rosebayhoa.com/documents under "Parking and Towing".
- 2. Cars should be parked with the flow of traffic and as close to the curb without getting on the grass. **Do not break your neighbor's sprinkler heads.**
- 3. Cars should not block the sidewalk and should not stick out into the roadway lane.
- 4. Cars should not block driveways of other homes. The tow truck driver will not know if you got permission from a Homeowner to park in front of their driveway, so please do not park in front of driveways under any circumstances.
- 5. Do not park in a neighbor's driveway without permission.
- 6. If you have a large number of guests, coordinate carpooling if possible.
- 7. Coordinate gate entry to avoid cars blocking entry into the Community and possibly causing an accident along Rose Avenue.
 - a. Do not give out the gate code.
 - b. You may need to stand at the gate and open it with your gate clicker.
- 8. Consider only parking on your side of the street to avoid causing issues for your neighbors with cars parked on both sides of the street.
 - a. Note that if there is a medical emergency and fire trucks need to get through, if cars are parked too far into the street, they may be damaged by the fire trucks.
 - b. If the person having the medical emergency is further hurt because emergency vehicles were hindered by your guest vehicles, you may be sued!
